City Announcements and Information related to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) and the Federal Governments declaration of a National Emergency.

City of Cheboygan Mayor Mark C. Bronson and City Manager Thomas E. Eustice have announced changes to the City operations and services to help combat the COVID-19 (coronavirus) and support the declared National Emergency.

- As of today March 15, 2020, and to and including April 5, 2020 the Cheboygan Recreation Center at 400 Cleveland Avenue and the Cheboygan Ice Pavilion at 480 Cleveland Avenue will be closed to the public. All scheduled activities have been suspended until at least April 6, 2020 or until further notice.
- All Public Assembly meetings of the Cities Boards and Commissions have been suspended including the regularly scheduled City Council meeting March 24, 2020. That does not include City staff, State and local agencies meetings and any meeting that does not require public participation under the Open Meetings Act. Any scheduled meeting that does not require public participation is not cancelled.
- All other City services and operations will function as normal. City Hall offices will be open at the regular hours of 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday – Friday. The public will be able to pay bills, make applications, view public records etc. as usual. However, the City is encouraging the public to use the on line utility billing pay option at www.cheboygan.org and limit in person contact inquires by using phone, fax or e-mail.
