





## 2010 Water Main Improvement Project

Construction will begin this summer on the 2010 Water Main Improvement Project to address water quality complaints and water main breaks. The project areas include replacing water mains as follows: North Main Street between Mackinaw Avenue and Lake Street; Duncan Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Marina Drive; Harrison Avenue between Eastern Avenue and Marina Drive; North C Street between East State Street and East First Street; North D Street between Fourth Street and Second Street; North E Street between E. State Street and Third Street; South E Street between East State Street and Sixth Street; East First Street between Coast Guard Drive and Duncan Avenue; Third Street between North B Street and Duncan Avenue; and West State Street between Main Street and North Ball Street. The project also includes disconnecting an old River crossing on East First Street between North B Street and Duncan Avenue; disconnect services from an old 4"-diameter cast iron water main & connect to a new 12" plastic main; abandon a 6" cast iron water main on West State Street between the former railroad track and Ball Street & reconnect services to new water main; and abandon a 4" cast iron water main on South F Street between Abbott Street and East State Street and reconnect services to new water main. [Of interest, the current water mains date back to 1881 – 1947). Wade Trim, Gaylord, is the engineer on the project. The project is made possible through a 40-year low-interest loan from the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development Program and an increase in water utility rates effective July 1, 2010. [see article below] The City asks for and appreciates your patience during this project as it strives to improve the water quality to all



## Water Rate Increases on July 1, 2010

recently City Council approved water utility rate increases effective July 1, 2010. The current rate for 1,000 gallons (1 unit) is \$3.43; the new rate will be \$4.71. This increase does not affect the sewer portion of the utility bill.

This increase was necessary in order to move forward with the 2010 Water Main Improvement Project.





## Grass & Weed Notice

Property owners, residential & business, are required to cut the right-of-way (berm area), as their personal as well property. City crews are mowing private properties that are in violation of the City Ordinance. The minimum charge is \$160/per hour and will be placed on property taxes levied in July. Also, the property owner can be cited for the violation.

## A MESSAGE TO BUSINESS **OWNERS ON PERSONAL** PROPERTY TAXES

The City Treasurer's Office reminds business owners that personal property taxes are levied in July and December of each year. [This is the tax on the furniture, equipment, etc. used in your business.] If you do not your July & receive both December personal property tax contact the Treasurer's Office at 627-9931.

Please remember that this system is for emergency situations, not for general information that can be obtained during normal working hours.

## WATER SHUT-OFF INFORMATION

Customers who have their water shut off and have to have Department of Public Works personnel restore service will be charged a \$40.00 Turn On This will include sea-Fee. customers. sonal nonpayment customers and anyone discontinuing service for a period of 30 days or more.



## **DELINQUENT** WATER/ **SEWER BILLS**

Pursuant to City Ordinance provisions, all water and/or sewer bills that have a delinquent balance as of September 1, 2009 (delinquent for over 6 months) will be placed as a tax lien on the 2010 City Tax Roll on July 1, 2010. Service could also be subject to shutoff status.

plumber first, the City will not be responsible for any costs.

#### RENTAL PRO PERTIES

Owners of rental properties are reminded to notify the billing staff at 627-3592 whenever there is a change in tenants. A meter read needs to be done in order to calculate a "final bill". Also, in order for the water/sewer bill to be in the tenant's name, a \$100 deposit is required by the tenant pursuant to policy set by the City Council. Otherwise the billing stays in the owner's name. Deposit money is kept in a separate account to be used on the final bill or returned if nothing is owed.



### **UNDERSTANDING YOUR** WATER/SEWER BILL

Codes: WA=Water; SI=Sewer; FS=Flat Sewer; WO=Out of Town Water: Meter Read: A=Actual E=Estimated Meter Read Bills are sent out quarterly; two bills have actual meter reads – the other two bills are estimated on past actual usage since meters cannot be read during the winter months.

## SECOND METER **READ REQUESTS**



When a water/sewer bill is guestioned and a second meter read is requested, there will be no charge. If an error is discovered it will be corrected by the City staff. If there is no error, the customer will be required to pay the original bill. During the next 24month period, if a second read is requested and there is no error. the customer will then be liable for a \$10.00 charge.

## A FEW WORDS ABOUT SIGNS & INOPERABLE VEHICLE

With the arrival of summer come new businesses and business ventures. With those comes the need for signs. With signs comes the need for permits from the City of Cheboygan under Chapter 152 of the City Ordinances titled "Signs." In short, this states that all new businesses and/or existing businesses adding new signs or changing existing signs are required to obtain sign permits at City Hall. This includes, but is not limited to, temporary signs, permanent signs, ground signs, wall signs, window signs, etc and also includes banners.

The City of Cheboygan Nuisance Ordinance and Sign Ordinance prohibit the erection of any type of signs or banners within any portion of a public right-of-way and prohibit the posting of signs on any power or telephone poles or off-premise postings. Persons wishing to advertise garage sales should do so through the local media and with a sign posted on their private property or on another person's private property with written permission. Yard or garage sales are not permitted for longer than seven (7) days in any 90-day period.

Persons are also reminded that City Ordinances prohibit unlicensed, uninsured, inoperable motor vehicles from being stored on property within the City of Cheboygan.

The Department of Public Works asks that you not place leaves, branches, yard clippings, etc. on the streets until the City clean-up in the late Fall. The date will be announced in early October. The City needs to have the streets clear in order to operate street-sweeping machinery. If you have any questions, please contact Steven F. ## PERMITS REQUIRED FOR WORK IN STREET RIGHTS-OF-WAY

Anyone planning to perform any type of work within a City street right-of-way <u>must</u> secure a Permit from the City of Cheboygan's Department of Public Works. Work requiring a Permit within a street right-of-way includes patch work, culvert installation, curb, sidewalk or driveway repair, tree or shrub planting or any other type of work within the street right-of-way. 

### SEA SO NAL REMINDERS FROM THE DEPARTMENT

## OF PUBLIC SAFETY







Motorized scooters, mini bikes and mini choppers are not allowed to operate on sidewalks. Mini choppers and other motorized bikes require a moped registration and a driver's license or a special moped operator's license (must be at least 15 years of age) to operate on streets if equipped with a headlamp, taillight and horn. Operators under 19 years of age must wear a helmet.

## ANIMAL CONTROL

Chapter 90, Sections 90.08 and 90.25 of the City Ordinance require that all persons walk their dogs on leashes and have them under control and that they clean up all manure deposited or accumulated upon any street, sidewalk, gutter, alley or private property.

### **SWIMMING**

City Ordinance **prohibits** swimming and/or diving into the lower Cheboygan River from the DNR locks and dam north to the mouth of the River at the Straits of Mackinac.

## DISORDERLY CONDUCT - NOISE

Chapter 95, Section 95.03 of the City Ordinance prohibits persons from playing loud vibrating music from motor vehicles. Other sections of City Ordinance and State Statute prohibit the playing of home stereos and recording devices in a loud manner, which would disturb the peace and quiet of a neighborhood.

### **INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES**

Chapter 94, Section 94.02 of the City Ordinance requires that all unlicensed, uninsured and/or inoperable motor vehicles be removed from private properties within the City or stored inside garages.

### **BURNING PERMITS**

All property owners, whether business or residential, are **required to obtain** a burning permit from the City of Cheboygan before open burning of any type is permitted. This includes small piles of brush, grass or leaves. Burning in burning barrels is also restricted and persons wishing to do so must obtain permission through the Cheboygan Department of Public Safety/Police or Fire Division (627-4321). Fines for violation of this Ordinance can amount to \$500.00 or more. **NO BURNING IF STATEWIDE BURNING BAN IS TEMPORARILY ENVOKED.**

Dry chemical fire extinguishers can be refilled at CarQuest, 122 S. Main St., Cheboygan (627-5691).

**SPEED LIMITS:** All City streets are <u>25 mph</u>, unless posted otherwise.


