**Staff Report:** Scott Hancock, Cheboygan Parks and Recreation Director, reported that he is hoping to open the Rec Center February 1, depending on what she says [ref. emergency orders from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services]. The Rec Center has been painted inside also. Snowshoe rental is going well, people have been checking

the equipment out for the day even though there hasn't been a lot of snow. Volleyball league will take place if last year's captains want to make it go. Lights have been changed over to LED. Eric from the city garage changed the lights, and Mr. Hancock expressed gratitude for that. Coach Coxe let the Rec staff borrow his scaffolding to complete projects. City Manager Tom Eustice purchased used tables for the Rec Center at a very good price from the school. The tables fold up to be used in the meeting room, they have benches so they are really good for when the kids come into play games. Saturday night gatherings for high school aged kids at the Rec Center are not scheduled to start taking place due to the pandemic. There is money left over still for pizza that was provided through donations but there are rules against providing food at events due to Covid restrictions.
